

GETTING TO KNOW THE BIBLE (A Review)

This is an excellent book filled with helpful information on how to study and arrive at the correct understanding of the Bible. The author, Kevin Moore, is a graduate of the East Tennessee School of Preaching and Freed-Hardeman University. He serves as a missionary in New Zealand. A lack of adequate Bible knowledge has left many of our people weak and vulnerable to the allurements of those who would change and corrupt the faith of the church. This book is written for the man and woman in the pew. In language and approach, the author studiously avoids the jargon and style of the seminary. This is in contrast with most of the literature promoting change. His chapters on the Inspiration of the Bible, the Old and New Covenants, the Biblical Pattern, Ascertaining the Lord's Will, and Divine Regulations and Cultural Conventions are extremely valuable and will truly fortify the faith of those who study them well. I recommend that elders use this book for a course of study for all their members from teens through adults.
